TAKE NOTICE that the Scarborough Borough Council at its meeting of 25 February 2011 confirmed by resolution its adoption of Sections 1 to 3, 13 to 15, Schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 and resolved to adopt Schedule 3 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 as amended by Section 27 of the Policing and Crime Act 2009 as from 1 April 2011.

The effect of the resolutions is to confirm the application of the existing provisions of the Act which provide for the regulation of Acupuncture, Tattooing, Ear-piercing, Electrolysis, Street Trading, Entertainment and Sex Establishments under Sections 1 to 3, 13 to 15 and Schedules 3 and 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 and to extend the existing controls on sex establishments under Schedule 3 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 such as sex shops and sex cinemas, so as to require from the 1st April 2011 any premises which provide frequent entertainment involving live performances involving nudity intended to be sexually stimulating, to make application to obtain a licence under the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 (as amended) as well as any licence that may be required pursuant to the Licensing Act 2003.

Notice is hereby given that on 4th March 2011 Scarborough Borough Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order prohibits the driving or waiting of vehicles in the following named roads in Scarborough between the 7th March and 18th March 2011.

Barmoor Lane, Scalby between North Street and Scalby Road.

Station Road, Crossgates between Cayton Low Road and its cul de sac end at Seamer Station.

High Street Service Road between Westway and the car park at the rear of Proudfoots.

Westbourne Grove between Valley Road and Ramshill Road.

Ramshill Road between West Street and Queen Margaret's Road.

Prince of Wales Terrace between West Street and Ramshill Road.

Church Lane between Castle Road and Paradise.

Paradise between Church Lane and Castlegate.

Musham Bank Road/Manham Hill/Westway Roundabout.

Scalby Road at its junction with Woodlands Drive.

Aberdeen Walk/Albemarle Crescent between Victoria Road/Castle Road and Westborough.

Seamer Road at its junction with Queen Margaret's Road.

It is envisaged that the works will take no longer than 7 days in each location and advance warning of all closures will be signed on site and notice given to frontages before any works commence.

Access for pedestrians to premises on or adjacent to the road or only accessible from the road will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to premises on or adjacent to the road or only accessible from the road will be maintained whenever possible.

The closures are necessary to allow for highway maintenance works.

The physical road closures will be put into effect by the erection of road signs and barriers.

The alternative routes for these closures will be signed locally.
