

The Local Government Workforce Survey is conducted annually by the Local Government Association's Research and Information team and collects information about the workforce within English councils. Where councils have given their permission, key data from this survey are uploaded to LG Inform and are publicly available. Councils are able to use this information to enable benchmarking and support improvement.

This report provides a comparison for all councils who have submitted data and allowed it to be shared.

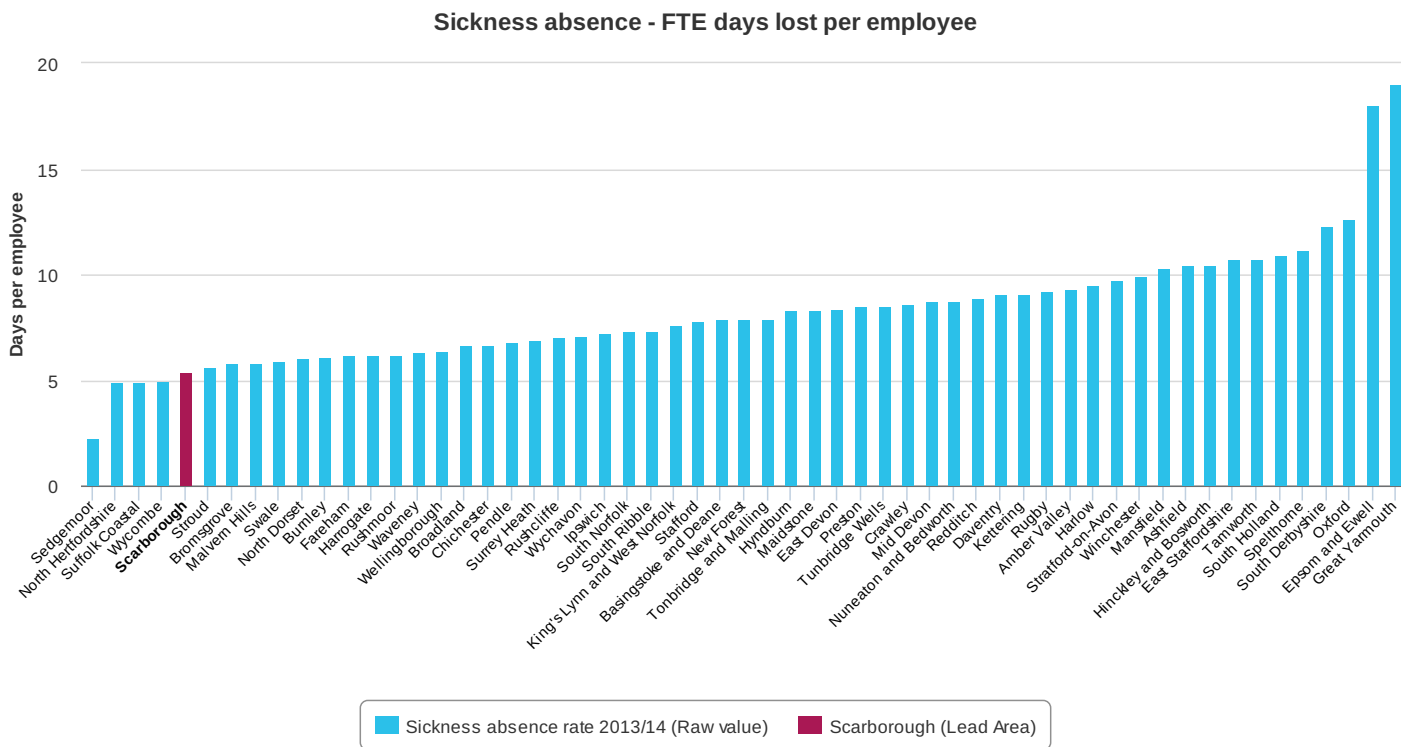
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All of these data include staff directly employed by councils. This includes school support staff working in maintained schools, but excludes teachers.
